Waste Characterization

Tank Cleaning and Closure

These projects involve draining and storage or disposal of liquids, sludge removal and disposal, and cleaning of aboveground or belowground tanks for inspection or closure. PMI has experience with tanks containing gasoline, fuel oil, polychlorinated biphenyls, and acids, as well as various solids such as fertilizer, ash, and resins. Tanks cleaned range in size from 1,000 gallon to over 1,000,000 gallons. Filtering of re-usable product has also been provided.

Industrial Pond Cleaning and Closures

Several projects involving sampling and disposal of pond sludge, obtaining permits from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the actual closure or filling in of the ponds with suitable fill materials. These projects have been completed at several power generation and industrial facilities in Arkansas and surrounding states. PMI has also performed several pond cleaning projects for Municipal Wastewater Treatment facilities.

Construction of over six (6) miles of all-weather access roads around the perimeter of ash landfills at two (2) coal burning power plants. PMI also constructed wet waste bulking facilities used for solidification of semi-solid wastes for disposal in ash landfills.

Installation of 10,000 linear feet of 4" water main, prefabricated booster/pumping station, and 26,000 gallon storage tank. This system supplies potable water from a municipal water system to the White Bluff Power Plant.

Asbestos Abatement & Building Demolition

This project involved the demolition and disposal of three (3) two-story buildings. Asbestos and non-asbestos containing materials were separated and disposed of at a permitted landfill. The site was then stripped and building pads were constructed for a new four-story bank building in Hope, Arkansas. In 2005, PMI completed an asbestos abatement and demolition project which involved a three story dormitory in Arkadelphia, Arkansas. Small scale projects such as Residential demolition are also common practices.

Vacuum Truck Services

Vacuum trucks are routinely used to remove solid and liquid materials from inaccessible areas or areas sensitive to conventional equipment. PMI has removed materials from as high as ten (10) stories or as low as 50 feet below ground. Common materials removed are ash, sand, rocks, coal, soil, petroleum products, acids, and water. These trucks are also equipped with a water jetting system, which along with powerful vacuum can excavate around and/or locate sensitive underground lines or structures. It can also be used to clean all types and sizes of piping and culverts.
