Annual Registrations & Self Audits

Under our new Compliance Monitoring Program (CMP) Pollution Management, Inc. will prepare and submit for your review and approval the ADEQ annual tank registration for UST's located at your facility. This service includes the review, completion of the registration form, and any necessary changes to the registration of the tank system for your facility. PMI will also complete the annual ADEQ self audit form for your facility and submit this form on your behalf to the Department. If you should own multiple facilities, PMI can customize your CMP to fit all your needs.

Miscellaneous Compliance Issues

From time to time, there will be miscellaneous compliance issues associated with your UST System. PMI can provide professional services to handle all of the miscellaneous items that could play a major factor in keeping your system in compliance with ADEQ requirements. PMI can provide such services as monitoring well installation, annual pressurized line testing, annual functionality line leak detector testing, site meetings with ADEQ inspectors to perform site leak detection inspections, monthly leak detection monitoring, on-site facility training, tank upgrades and tank closure requirements. Other miscellaneous items which could factor into the program would be submittals to ADEQ which would indicate any unusual operating circumstances associated with the

operations of the monthly leak detection and/or inspection of the regulated tank system. There are many such items which play a major role in your compliance and/or noncompliance status.

Trust Fund Certificate

Every owner or operator of an Underground Petroleum Storage Tank system is required by 40 CFR 280.93 to demonstrate financial responsibility for taking corrective action in response to accidental releases from UST systems. In order to be eligible for the trust fund, the owner or operator must

- 1.) Register each petroleum storage tank and pay the annual storage tank fees required by the regulation for each tank until such time as the permanent closure requirements of the regulation are satisfied;
- 2.) Maintain financial responsibility in the amount of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) per occurrence for corrective action cost, by any one or combination of the following: insurance, guaranty, surety bond, letter of credit, insurance pool or any other mechanism allowed by 40 CFR 280; and
- 3.) For each petroleum storage tank for which trust fund eligibility is sought, certify on forms supplied by the Department that he or she has completed and submitted an annual self inspection audit form to the Department.
